## INFORMATION REGARDING BUILDING PERMITS AND BUILDING CODE CONTRAVENTIONS

If you are planning to construct, renovate, or add to a building in the Township of Emo it is probable that you will need to obtain a Building Permit. Most building projects require a Building Permit and it must be obtained **prior** to the start of the work.

The Province takes seriously the matter of contravention of the Building Code Act and the Building Code. Fines can be levied for such things as "starting construction without first obtaining a Building Permit" – "Occupying a building prior to obtaining an Occupancy Permit" – "Failing to comply with an Order".

For more information regarding the need to obtain a Building Permit, information regarding the schedule of relevant fines or just general information regarding your plans to construct please contact the Township of Emo Chief Building Official at the Municipal Office.
